

E-911 ADDRESSING

PLEASE POST YOUR ADDRESS!

To assist emergency services, post your emergency 911, i.e., E-911 numbers at the entrance to your driveway and on the frontage of the structure. Numbers need to be visible from the road and should be 5" high with a minimum stroke of 0.5" and a contrasting background in accordance with City Fire Code regulations as amended from time to time.

WHAT IS AN E-911 ADDRESS?

An E-911 address is a site location address assigned to individual businesses and residences. Typically, measurements start at the south or west end of a through road.

WHY DO I NEED AN E-911 ADDRESS?

Primarily, to assist emergency services in responding to emergency calls. An E-911 address helps emergency services to locate residents. A faster response time can make a significant difference in survival and degree of recovery.

HOW DO I OBTAIN A RESIDENTIAL E-911 ADDRESS?

Before a residential building permit can be issued by the City of Daphne Building Inspections Department, an E-911 address number must be issued by the Department of Community Development. The E-911 number issued should be displayed properly on the structure and at the driveway and/or mailbox, in accordance with United States Parcel Service standards.

HOW DO I OBTAIN A COMMERCIAL E-911 ADDRESS?

For new commercial construction, an E-911 address is assigned upon the issuance of a site disturbance permit by the Department of Community Development.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Vacant lots are not addressed.
- Business suites are not assigned by the city, but rather the business owners or leaseholders for each property.
