

**CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA
ORDINANCE 2019-03**

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION: VILLAGE POINT BOARDWALK

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2018-35 approved and adopted the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget on October 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget, the City Council has determined that certain appropriations are required and should be approved and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget; and

WHEREAS, the City of Daphne received damages from Hurricane Nate which made landfall on October 8, 2017; and

WHEREAS, as a result of storm, the Village Point Boardwalk sustained severe damage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Daphne previously bid out the Village Point Boardwalk Replacement and awarded the project; and

WHEREAS, FEMA grant monies are available for 75% of the project cost and State of Alabama monies for 12.5% of the project costs for the Village Point Boardwalk Replacement project

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2018-11 appropriated \$27,408 for cost not reimbursed by FEMA or the State of Alabama and an additional appropriation of \$4,000 is needed additional improvements for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA, that

1. This project is deemed as key to the recovery efforts associated with this rain event and the repair of this public infrastructure is necessary to preserve the health, safety, and convenience of the public.
2. Fiscal Year 2019 Budget is hereby amended to include an appropriation in the amount of **\$4,000** from the **Lodging Tax Fund** for additional improvements for the Village Point Boardwalk for cost not reimbursed by FEMA or the State of Alabama.
3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute all documents associated with the described project.
