

**CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA
ORDINANCE 2019-45**

**APPROPRIATION: ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY
AFFAIRS (ADECA) GRANT MATCH FOR THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM (RTP)
TO CONSTRUCT A WALKING TRAIL AT VILLAGE POINT PRESERVE –
GRANT #18-RT-54-05**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-43 approved and adopted the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget on October 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget, the City Council has determined that certain appropriations are required and should be approved and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget; and

WHEREAS, the City of Daphne submitted a grant to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) Recreational Trails Program (RTP) to construct a walking trail at Village Point Preserve; and

WHEREAS, the ADECA selected the City of Daphne to participate in the Recreational Trails Program with a Federal Grant Award of \$210,206 and City match of \$52,552 (Ordinance #2018-45).

WHEREAS, the project was bid resulting in a base bid amount of \$246,720 which will require an additional appropriation of \$29,392 to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAPHNE, ALABAMA, that

1. Additional appropriation in the amount of \$29,392 from the General Fund are appropriated and made a part of the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget for the construction of a Boardwalk at Village Point Preserve.
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required in order for the City of Daphne to request funding consideration from ADECA and to participate in such project.
